### 2017 Floor Standard for KS2

St Mary's is above the floor standard set by the DfE for 2017 because the progress of children at the school exceeded the expected standards in reading, writing and maths.

The floor standard set by the DfE for children reaching Age Related Expectation in combined reading, writing and mathematics was 65%. At St Mary's 61% of children reached this standard.

Our data has shown a significant increase for 2017 in pupil outcomes in all areas of the curriculum at Key Stage One and at Key Stage Two.
