Computing - We will be revising eSafety through the following units:

- Talking safely online
- Super Digital Citizen
- Privacy Rules
- What's Cyberbullying?
- Selling Stereotypes.

Finally, we will be producing work using multi-media for our Independent Project.

R.E. - The children will learn about Christianity through three units:

- What does it mean if God is holy and loving?
- Creation and science: conflicting or complementary?
- Was Jesus the Messiah?

These lessons will be shared with South Africa Class.

PSHCE - We will cover two SEAL units which are 'New Beginnings' and 'Relationships'. We will begin Sex Education just before half term and more information will follow on this in due course.

Art - This will be taught by Mrs Robinson. The children will learn about pencil sketching and link their art work to WW2 and Blitz Art.

Music - The children will have a go at writing a song based on their research of WW2 songs. They may have the opportunity to go to the Weald for music enrichment either this term or Spring term.

D&T - The children will be design and make an Anderson Shelter.

P.E. - The children will need their P.E. kits on Tuesday and Friday each week. Please ensure the kit is named. One session will be based outdoors (weather permitting - Friday) and one session indoors (Tuesday - gymnastics). Outdoor sessions will cover football and netball. Children will need P.E. shirts and shorts, outdoor shoes, long trousers and jumper or tracksuit for outdoors.
