



New Zealand Class Summer Update

With less than two weeks to go before the summer holidays, New Zealand class would like to share with you some of the things we have been learning about since half term.

Maths week

We had a fantastic Maths week making our sensational structures using materials such as cardboard tubes, straws, newspaper and sellotape. After designing and working out the cost of the materials (they had a £10 budget) that the children were going to use, they then created their structures. The highest free-standing structure from New Zealand class was 44cm.

Science

This term we have been looking at the different types of teeth that humans have and what their particular function is. We also got to share the differences between human teeth and animal teeth that the children researched for their homework.

Literacy

We have been looking at stories with historical settings and in particular, stories set in Ancient Egypt. The children began creating a setting for their story before thinking about the

main characters. They then created a story board. This week, they will write their stories in full.

Art week

We had a very enjoyable art week linked to Ancient Egypt. The children created papyrus drawings which are now on display around the classroom along with our life sized Egyptian coffins. The children also created Ancient Egyptian jewellery and had the chance to practise drawing the mask of Tutankhamun using squares.
