#### Learning

**Young Voices** - St Mary's attended the Young Voices concert at the O2 Arena in London. The day started with a rehearsal of the songs with conductor David Lawrence. He took the children through their paces before we met Jacob Collier, a Grammy Awards winner and singer/songwriter of Little Blue. We then met MC Grammar, Tommy Blaize (singer on Strictly Come Dancing) and Souparnika Nair (semi-finalist on Britain's Got Talent in 2020 at the age of 10) and Urban Strides (the most fantastic dancers to inspire the children). It was a fantastic night of performing to a huge audience! Thank you to the staff that attended and made the trip happen.









Maths in school – This week there have been Maths lessons that really inspired learning. Y2 have been dealing with money, sorting coins and dealing with real life problems. SL classes working wall shows the lessons they have had using bar models and division. The children in Italy Class have been using maths frames this week to consolidate their understanding of numbers. These are them in action.









Science – Year 6 have been learning all about refraction in Science using practical examples.







**Dough Disco** – The children in Thailand and UK are developing the strength in their hands with Dough Disco. The children were so engaged and we are seeing the impact of this in Drawing Club.







**Hawk moth** – UK class have Giant Hawk Moth caterpillars at the moment who are due to start their chrysalis transformation very soon – what a fantastic learning experience!





**Phonics** – We have been blending and segmenting this week using active and engaging phonics activities to get the children really thinking about how they spell much longer words.


