- Tasks explore our topics: 'Into the Unknown' and 'Princes, Peasants and Pestilence.'
- Maths: TT Rockstars and Maths with a Mouse – little and often!
- By Year 5 and 6, it is imperative that the children know their multiplication and division facts. Quick recall will help them in many areas of their Maths learning this year. Please encourage them to keep practising.

Reading Logs and Spellings

- Reading logs are checked daily by Mrs Hayes and me.
- Children do not need to record every day, but they do need to bring it to school.
- 3 x per week at a minimum.
- Please encourage personal comments – see page 3 of the logs for prompt questions.
- Accelerated Reader and MyOn: online platform for reading. Please encourage children to complete the relevant quiz once they have finished their book.
- Weekly spellings are tested on Monday. Spelling books remain in school and word lists will be uploaded to Google Classroom.
