Curriculum

English -

Ist half term: We will be writing stories inspired by 'Stone Age Boy'. We will also be writing instructions.

2nd half term: We will study and analyse poetry about rivers. We will write our own pieces of poetry.

Maths. -

1st half term:

- Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction
 2nd half term:
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and Division

Science -

Ist half term: We will be learning all about rocks.

2nd half term: During the second half term we will be learning about Forces and Magnets.

PE -

Ist half term: We will be swimming every Wednesday. Mrs Castle will take the children for outdoor PE on a Tuesday afternoon.

2nd half term: Dance will start in the hall, the day will be confirmed closer to the time. Mrs Castle will teach outdoor PE.

Spanish -

The children will be taught Spanish each week by Miss Bell. During the Autumn term, they will cover: Greetings, saying how we're feeling, numbers up to 12, saying our age, naming colours and Christmas in Spain.

History -

1st half term:

Stone Age!

We will learn all about life during the Stone Age. We will explore this through our history lessons, as well as through a range of texts; including, 'Stig of the Dump'.

Geography -

2nd half term: Flow!

During the second half term, we will be learning about rivers. This will include how rivers are formed and why rivers are so important to us.

Art -

Ist half term - We will be exploring warm and cool colours. We will also investigate cave paintings, using 'The First Drawing' as a stimulus.

D&T -

2nd half term – We will be making water wheels during our Design and Technology lessons.

RE -

Ist half term: We will be learning about the Creation Story, followed by Dharma.

2nd half term: We will be investigative Incarnation.

Music -

Ist half term: We will be learning a song called 'Let your Spirit Fly'.

2nd half term: We will be learning how to play the Glockenspiel.

Computing -

Ist half term: We will be learning about how to be safe online.

2nd half term: We will be revisiting and extending our understanding of Coding.

RHE - 1st half term: We will be learning about Drugs and Tobacco.

2nd half term: We will be learning about bullying.

Please note that all RHE lessons follow our curriculum and are age-appropriate.
