Curriculum

English -

Ist half term: We will be writing our own stories based on the book the 'Stone Age Boy'.

2nd half term: We will be studying and analysing poetry about rivers, before writing our own pieces of poetry.

Maths. -

1st half term:

Science -

Ist half term: We will be learning all about rocks. In our very first science lesson, we will be making igneous and sedimentary chocolate rocks!

2nd half term: We will be learning about Forces and Magnets.

PE -

Ist half term: We will be swimming every Monday. Mrs. Burbidge will take the children for Hockey on a Friday morning.

2nd half term:

Dance will start in the hall; the day will be confirmed closer to the time. Mrs. Burbidge will be teaching Netball.

Spanish -
