



REQUEST FOR ABSENCE FROM LEARNING 2025 / 2026

Pupils are only in school for 190 days each year. **There are 175 other days for holidays and other activities.** 80% attendance represents **one day off every week**. 90% attendance represents **1 day off every fortnight**. There is no entitlement to, and headteachers are not permitted by law to grant, absences for holidays in term time – 'any application for leave must be in exceptional circumstances and the Headteacher must be satisfied that the circumstances warrant the granting of leave'. If a family choose to take their child / children out of school for a holiday, they may be subject to a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) or court summons. All unauthorised absences of 10 sessions (5 school days) or more are referred to West Sussex County Council for an FPN. Please complete this form and return to the school office. 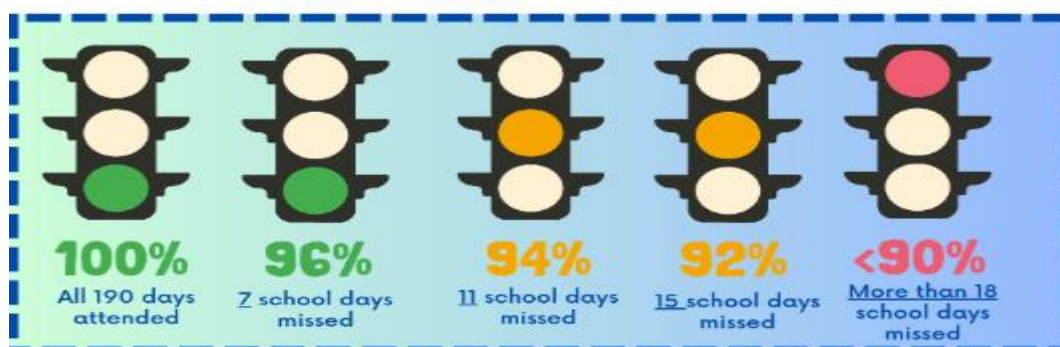
