Quick notices:

Reading logs: Mrs Shepherd and I will be checking reading logs each day. Please ensure that you are reading with your child at least three times a week and that this is recorded in their log.

Homework: Homework will be uploaded half termly, in the grid format, to Google Classroom. Parents/carers please then photograph or scan the children's homework tasks and upload them to Google Classroom. Alternatively the children can hand it into me at school, or it can be emailed.

Spellings: We are using a new scheme this year called 'spelling shed' to help children learn their spellings. Logins will be provided so that you can practise the spellings via spelling shed. They will also be on Google classroom. Spellings will be handed out on Monday and tested the following Monday.

Allergies - we are a **nut-free** school. We politely request that you ensure your children do not bring nuts into school as a snack or in their packed lunches. This includes any food item that may contain nuts.

English - 1st half term: We will be writing persuasive letters urging people to stop deforestation 2nd half term: We will be writing diary entries as if we have travelled to America.	Maths - 1st half term: • Place Value • Addition and Subtraction 2nd half term: • Addition and Subtraction • Multiplication and Division	Science - 1st half term: We will be learning all about living things and their habitats with a focus on classification. 2nd half term: During the second half term we will be learning about electricity.
PE - 1st half term: We will be swimming every Thursday. Mrs Burbidge will take the children for hockey on a Friday morning. 2nd half term: Dance will start in the hall; the day will be confirmed closer to the time. Mrs Burbidge will be teaching Netball.	Spanish - The children will be taught Spanish each week by Miss Bell. During the Autumn term, they will cover: Greetings, saying how we're feeling, numbers up to 12, saying our age, naming colours and finding out about Christmas in Spain.	Geography - 1st half term: Rumble in the Jungle! In this unit of work, we will learn all about the rainforests around the world 2nd half term: Road Trip USA We will be learning all about the physical and human geography in USA.
