If you receive an email you're not quite sure about, forward it to the Suspicious Email Reporting Service (SERS): <a href="mailto:report@phishing.gov.uk">report@phishing.gov.uk</a> <b>2 - Shopping online</b> If you're making a purchase from a company or person you don't know and trust, carry out some research first, for example, by checking to see if others have used the site and what their experience was. If you decide to go ahead with the purchase, use a credit card if you have one, other payment providers may not provide the same protection. <b>3 - Unsolicited calls and browser pop-ups offering tech support</b> Never install any software, or grant remote access to your computer, as a result of a cold call. Remember, legitimate organisations would never contact you out of the blue to ask for financial details such as your PIN or full banking password

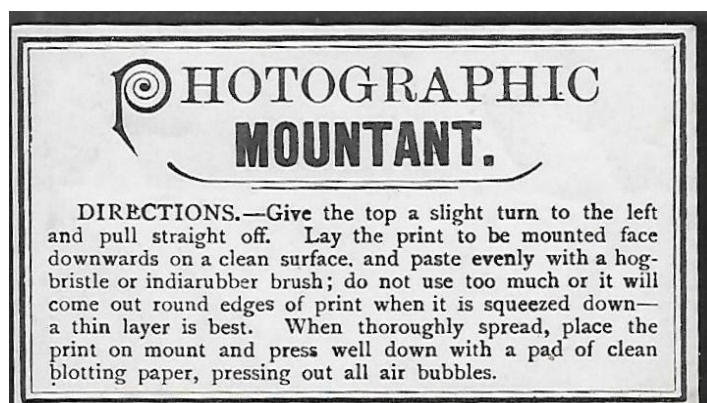
