Coronavirus and school action – We continue to monitor this situation very closely with Public Health England and West Sussex County Council. The Government have gone to delay phase and we have actioned this in school. There is a copy of this on our website. We would ask that you inform the school if you are aware of any cases in your family so we can monitor the situation as closely as possible. We also would ask that you inform us if any close family members have returned from abroad within the last month.

From Monday, we will be blowing the whistle at 8.40am just to allow the staff to get all the children through the hand washing procedures in the morning. This is an important part of what we are doing now and we need time to ensure it is thorough. We will be having a staggered lunch hour so that we don't have all the children eating together at once. We will be stopping whole school assemblies and sitting at desks more than on the floor. These are all precautionary measures at this time.

If we were to close, we do have contingency plans in place to send learning out to the children via email and this will come out to parents if we have to close. If your child doesn't have passwords to My Maths and TT Rockstars then please do ask the class teacher.

**Reports** – You will receive your child's school report today – please do read it and sign the reply form. The report is a reflection of where your child is now and how we can work together to show even more progress for your child.

**Parents evening** – We are still planning to run parents evening at this time, however this may change. The big hall will be the meeting point for parents to look at children's learning. Then the teachers will be in the small hall, China class and the open area in between.
