Wordships Game

Words with the long 'a' spelt as 'ei'.

Instructions:


- Choose four words from the list to make your Wordships. You need 2 × 4 letter words, 1 × 5 letter word and 1 × 6 letter word.
- Write these words on your My Words grid. They can be horizontal or vertical. See example on the next page. Now start playing!
- 3. Choose who will be Captain A and who will be Captain B.
- 4. A calls out a grid position, like "B5".
- B looks at their My Words grid and says, "Hit" or "Miss" depending on if a letter from a Wordship is there.
- 6. A writes "H" for a hit or "M" for miss on the Enemy Words grid.
- 7. If it's a hit, have another go. If it's a miss, now it's B's turn.
- 8. When one of you has hit all the letters in the Wordship, your partner must read the word to you. Then, you must spell it out loud. You are NOT allowed to look at the List of Spelling Words - that's cheating!
- 9. If you spell it correctly, you sink the ship!
- If you spell it incorrectly, your partner writes the word again in another part of their grid.
- 11. The winner is the captain who sinks all of their partner's Wordships.

You will need:


- A partner
- My Words and Enemy Words grids for each person.
- The list of spelling words.
- A pencil

Put your four Wordships on your My Words grid. You can write the letters horizontally or vertically.


4-letter word
