

Think about where, when and how they travelled, what they looked like and any other interesting facts.</p> 	<p><u>Similarities and Differences:</u> Pick a city to compare to London. Select a destination of your choice, plan a holiday for someone travelling to this destination (7 or 14 days) and work out how much it is going to cost. You must include flights, hotel, food and an activity for them to do while they are on holiday.</p>	<p>Produce top trump style cards for footballers from around the world. You must include two, three or four digit numbers. You might want to include speed, agility, goals in a season etc.</p> 	<p>Create number sentences written in a different language for example Spanish, French or maybe even Mandarin!</p> 	<p>Create a record of the weather for the week, presenting your findings in a table.
