CLAIM SUPPORT FOR BUSINESSES & SELF EMPLOYED PEOPLE	CLAIM BEFORE 19th OCTOBER	CLAIM A GRANT THROUGH THE SELF-EMPLOYED INCOME SUPPORT SCHEME If you're self-employed or a member of a partnership and have been adversely affected by coronavirus (COVID-19) use this scheme if you're eligible to claim the grant. The scheme is now open. If you're eligible and your business has been adversely affected on or after 14 July 2020, you must make your claim for the second grant on or before 19 October 2020.
