After half term, we will continue with the **IN / OUT** Gate system and at pick-up, we would ask that you wear a mask on the playground until further notice.

During the school day, our break & lunch times will remain staggered to ensure we minimise risks.

Louis (Ita) for spreading the seeds of love by tucking in chairs and sweeping the floor to clear up. All without being asked to do so.




