<p>PULBOROUGH SOCIETY</p>		<p>NEWS FROM THE PULBOROUGH SOCIETY Comments or objections have been submitted to the Codmore Hill Travellers Site, The Coppice Hanger proposal on School Hill, and the 'amended footpath' on the Brookfields Development, Hardham Tunnel - in 1790 Pulborough's river access was 'bypassed' with the opening of the canal and tunnel from Coldwaltham passing under Hardham Hill to re-join the Arun near Stopham; this saved three miles of navigation around the lengthy curve through (what is now) Pulborough Brooks. The 357 metre Hardham Tunnel has recently been given Listed Grade II status by Historic England – the result of a three-year campaign by local resident Paul Messis.</p>
