Quick notices:

Spellings: Spellings will be handed out on Monday and tested the following Monday. These will be uploaded to Google Classroom, as well as strategies to help your child learn their spellings.

Swimming: This is on a Tuesday every week up until half term. Please provide permission for your child to wear goggles to the office staff.
