PULBOROUGH MEDICAL GROUP

Covid Booster Update 20 September 2021 PMG are starting to call in patients for their Covid booster injections. Patients will be prioritised by those who are most at risk and those with the longest interval since their second dose. Patients will be contacted by phone, text or by letter to invite them to book an appointment. If your flu vaccine is also due then you can have it at the same time. Please let the receptionist know when booking your appointment.

The GP appointment system is currently being reviewed, so there are only doctors' appointments available until the 1st October. If you need a non-urgent appointment with a doctor, contact the surgery after 2 p.m. on Tues. 21st September when they anticipate GP appointments will be available for October.

FLU all clinics booked from the 13th Sept will be going ahead as planned. Appointments are available to book for patients 50+, those aged 18+ in clinical risk groups, carers, pregnant ladies and frontline health & social care staff. Either use the NHS App online or telephone 01798 872815.
