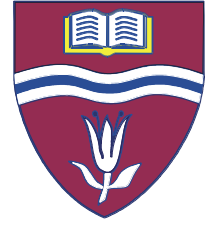


St. Mary's CE (Aided) Primary School, Pulborough

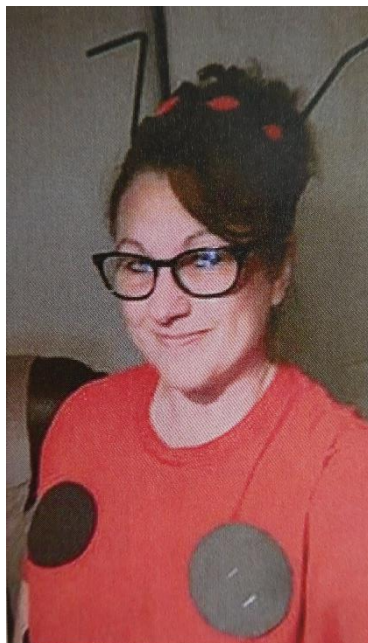

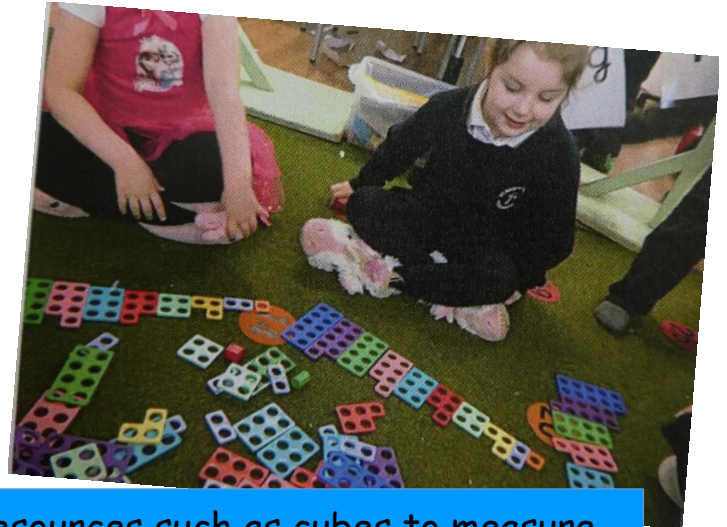
Phonic activities on our whiteboard

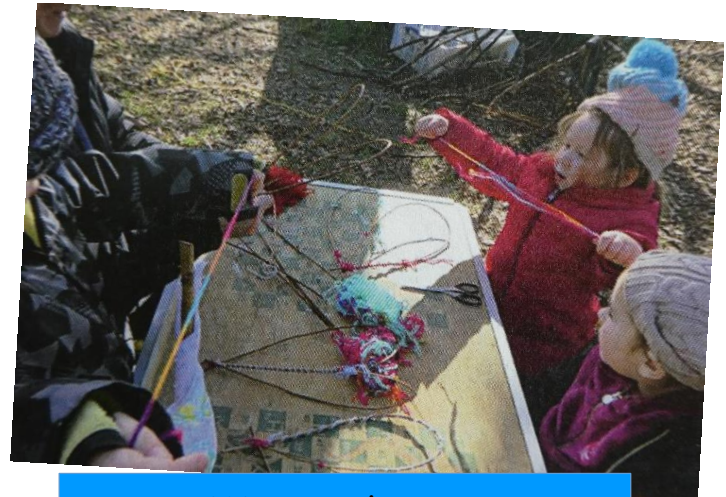

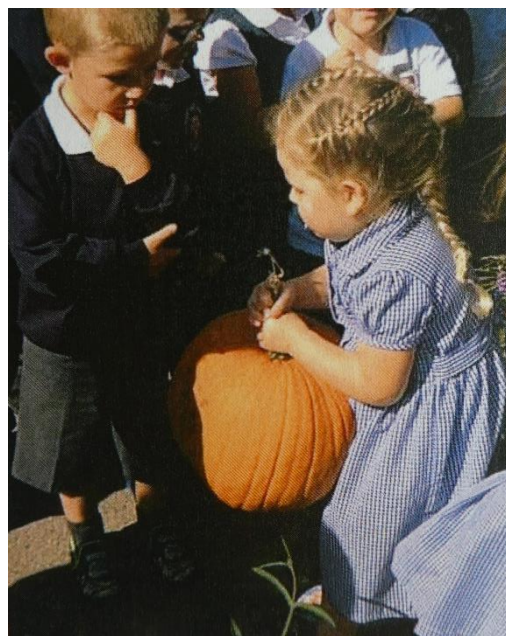


We go to Lambing Live at Stable Barn Farm



Then to Dell Quay in the summer.

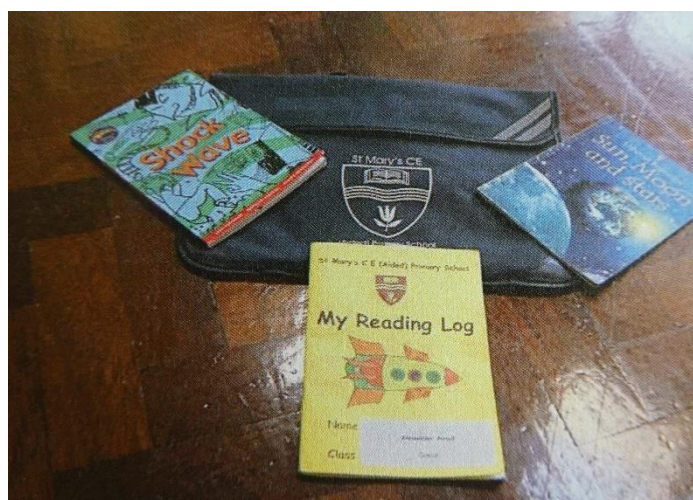
What You Need for School

We will provide you with a book bag.



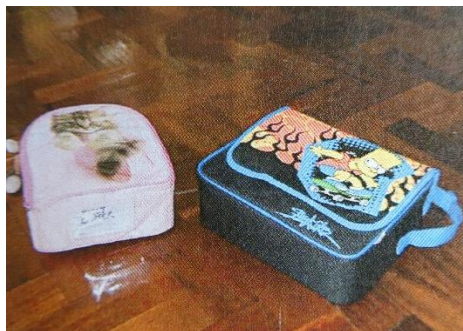
You will need wellies and waterproofs for Forest School..
